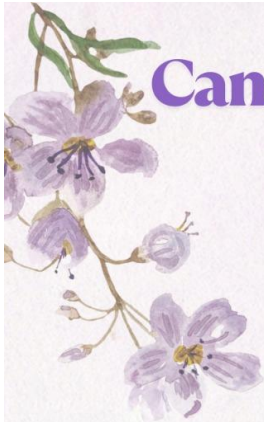

ST. MAGDALENE OF CANOSSA



Born: 1st March, 1774

Died : 10th April, 1835

Foundress of the Canossian Daughters of Charity

MAGDALENE GABRIELLE OF CANOSSA was born in Verona on 1st March, 1774. At the age of five, she lost her father. At seven her mother remarried leaving all her five children in the Canossa Palace.

She was then entrusted to a governess who did not understand her and caused her to suffer much. She had just overcome this painful ordeal when she fell ill. Her long suffering brought her closer to God and Magdalene decided to consecrate herself wholly to Him.

Before knowing what was to be her mission in life, Magdalene tried the cloistered life. The experiment convinced her that she was called to something else, so she returned home where she humbly and patiently awaited enlightenment from God. She dedicated herself to the care of His dear ones with great love, giving help, comfort and serenity to all those whom she encountered.

In 1797 when Napoleon's troops occupied Verona, Magdalene sought refuge in Venice, where she experienced the difficulties and sadness of being in exile.

After returning to her native city, she was moved by the sight of the many miseries which were the lot of the poor. What impressed her the most was the frightening state of so many

children and ignorant young girls, left to themselves and exposed to numerous dangers. Urged by ardent charity, she began to look out for them, assist and educate them and act as a mother to them. She was helped in this work by generous collaborators.

In 1808, free at last from all obligations to her family, she finally left her rich palace to live a poor life and serve the poor in the parish of St. Zeno, the most destitute in the whole of Verona.

She had thus given life to the Institute of the Daughters of Charity, commonly known as 'Canossians' which was especially dedicated to Catechesis, education of the neediest among poor girls and the assistance of sick women in public hospitals.

A few years later, the institute came to Venice where Magdalene of Canossa would define its spirit and finalities, thence to Milan, Bergamo and Trent.

Ever since, the foundations have multiplied themselves. It is now two hundred years since the Daughters of Charity realised the great dream-that of making Christ known to the extreme ends of the world. Today the Sisters are found in all continents, where they are committed to witness Christ in the exercise of all the works of mercy. Magdalene of Canossa is also the foundress of the Sons of Charity, who share the same apostolic aim as the Daughters of Charity.

She died on 10th April, 1835. Her typical virtues were, 'Humility in Charity' and 'Charity in Humility'.

She proposes Jesus Crucified and His sorrowful Mother as models for imitation to all the members of her congregation.

On October 2nd 1988, Pope St. John Paul II declared her a SAINT.

ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA



Born: In the year 1869

Died: 8th February, 1947

BAKHITA was born in the region of SUDAN -AFRICA in 1869.

As a little girl, this African flower, knew the anguish of slavery and kidnapping. She was stolen by slave-traders and cruelly tortured. In this traumatic experience, the little girl, could not remember her name and was named BAKHITA, which means 'The Lucky One'.

After being sold and resold in the markets of EL-Obeid and Khartoum, she was finally bought by an Italian Consul. For the first time now, Bakhita experienced being loved and cared for, as a person. At her insistent request, she went with the Italian Consul, to Italy. She was then given as a present to a couple that had a little daughter. Through them she came to know the Canossian Daughters of Charity in Venice.

She asked to be baptized as a Catholic. She then asked to offer herself totally to God, as a Canossian Sister. On 8th December 1896, she pronounced her First Vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience. Simple, yet humble, she was full of love for God and neighbour. She was engaged in unassuming duties in the Canossian Convent. She was a portress, welcoming little girls and their mothers, who came to love this gentle, black sister. She worked for sometime in the kitchen, serving her sisters with attention and love. She was excellent in embroidery and served as a Sacristan in the chapel.

On 8th February 1947, she breathed her last at the age of 78, in Schio-Italy. She was declared Blessed on 17th May 1992, and publicly acknowledged a Saint in Rome on 1st October, 2000.

Bakhita is revered as a Saint, because she is a 'Universal Sister'. She became holy by doing every little thing with great love for God and for her neighbour. She was always cheerful and smiling, even when afflicted with arthritis. She never harboured thoughts of revenge or resentment against her captors. Infact, she prayed ardently for them and thanked God that through her kidnapping, He had brought her into the Catholic faith.

Let us pray through her intercession for whatever graces we may be in need of.

M. FERNANDA RIVA



Born: 17th April, 1920

Died: 22nd January, 1956

Fernanda Riva was born on April 17, 1920, in Monza, Italy. She was the fourth and the youngest child. She was barely three months old when her father died at the early age of 33.

Fernanda was a model student in school, intelligent, modest and sweet in her ways. As teenager she attended the Oratorio of the Canossian Daughters of Charity and participated in various activities. She excelled in Catechism, throwball and drama and in sharing fun and joy through her acting in skits. She cultivated an intense spiritual life and took a lively interest in helping others. With enthusiasm and discreet tact she succeeded in attracting several of her friends to attend Sunday School.

She succeeded brilliantly in her studies and though Fernanda would have liked to pursue higher studies at the University, because of the financial straits of her family she preferred to work as a salesgirl. She studied privately, completing a Higher Secondary Course.

Fernanda entered the Missionary Institute of the Canossian Sisters in Vimercate, Milan, on March 19, 1939. Seeing that she had a balanced personality and was prepared spiritually, she was sent some months later to India. She continued her Novitiate in Belgaum. She was an exemplary novice in the fulfilment of her duties, especially in the practice of obedience, charity and humility.

M. Fernanda was appointed Headmistress, in 1951, of Canossa High School, Mahim, Mumbai. There were nearly 2000 students on roll. Here, too, she was very successful in promoting the growth of the School in all its activities, uniting the Staff and students and obtaining obedience from all, through her loving ways rather than using her authority as a Headmistress.

M. Fernanda was transferred to St. Joesph's Convent, Alleppey, Kerala, where the Canossian Sisters had been asked to begin a College for Women. Sr. Fernanda supervised the construction of the College building and became the first Principal of the College in June 1954. Sr. Fernanda was much loved and appreciated by the staff and students of the college.

She gave them her individual attention and by her sweet ways united them all into one big family.

M. Fernanda's health again began to decline. She was sent to Mumbai in 1954 and was operated for malignant stomach ulcers. After some rest, she returned to Alleppey and resumed her duties with the same zest she had before, and promoted new initiatives.

Despite all her suffering, she never uttered a single complaint. She remained calm, serene, prayerful and concerned only for others. She joyfully welcomed death. She was fully conscious till the end which came at the early hours of January 22, 1956. She was 35 years of age. She was buried in St. Michael's cemetery, Mahim.

Let us pray for the cause of her canonization which was introduced on August 13th, 1994 at St. Michael's Church, Mahim, Mumbai.

CANOSSA HIGH SCHOOL

**UNDER THE DIRECTION OF
THE CANOSSIAN DAUGHTERS OF CHARITY**

- Canossa School situated in Mahim, was started in 1932 as a Primary School, annexed to the Parish of Our Lady of Victories. It was recognized as a High School in 1946. Canossa High School is a Catholic School for Girls, established and administered by the Canossian Daughters of Charity. The School is under the jurisdiction of the Archbishop of Mumbai.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- Canossa High School aims primarily at the education of the Catholic Community and the preservation of the Catholic faith and religious practices.
- Preference in admission to the School will be given to Catholic children. Admission, however, is open to children of other communities without distinction of caste or creed.
- With a view to preserving our Catholic faith, classes in Religion are conducted and it is obligatory for Catholic students to attend these classes. The Non- Catholic students are taught Moral Science, a course about their fundamental duties to God, to their fellow beings and to self.
- The School stands for academic excellence, development of skills and character formation based on the love of God and the service of persons. The all-round development of our students and their sincere commitment to God and Country is given

priority. Intellectual training is imparted through instruction aiming at academic excellence, helping them to think for themselves and arrive at the right judgement.

- Physical Education is promoted with the purpose of developing a sound mind in a healthy body. Programmes offered are Physical Training, Apparatus Drill and special coaching in athletics, football, etc.
- Emotional and social training is encouraged through the House System, Class Democracy, Leadership, Teamwork and Works of Mercy conducted through the Pragati Shikshan classes, Three Coins Collections, Tuck-shops. Outreach Programs etc.
- Cultural training is fostered through co-curricular activities like Dramatics, Dance, Elocution, Singing, etc.
- We aim at training our students to be simple, honest, kind and cheerful, both in school and at home, ever-ready to be of service to the needy and the downtrodden, to be proud citizens of our Country and to be inspiring messengers of change in the world of today.
- The course of instruction includes all the subjects prescribed by the Government for English Teaching Schools in Maharashtra State. The school is subject to Inspection by the Department of Education, Government of Maharashtra. The School comprises of standards from 5 to 10 and prepares the students for the SSC Board Examination.

REGULATIONS

ADMISSIONS

For admission into the School, the following information must be given: Name and Surname, Date and Place of Birth, Religion and Caste along with photocopies of Baptismal or Birth Certificate, School Leaving Certificate (if coming from another school.)

FEES

1. The intended withdrawal of a student should be notified in writing at least a month in advance by a responsible person, otherwise her name will be kept on the register and the corresponding fee will be charged.
2. A student who is the fourth and subsequent child is entitled to pay fees as per the Government rules.
3. A student whose parents are not residents of Maharashtra for more than 15 years has to pay the recommended fees as per Government rules.
4. Fees and other payments must be made on time.
5. Children who have repeated the Std. have to pay fees

GENERAL RULES

“Discipline is the bridge between goals and accomplishment.”

According to the revised Educational Code, the Parents / Guardians of the students are to be informed of the following rules.

1. Parents have no right to dictate to the Management but the Management of the School has a right to decide on what conditions they will admit or retain a student in their School.
2. The Parents and Guardians should follow the School Rules regarding admissions, examinations, promotions and the payment of the fees as given in the Calendar.
3. Parents and Guardians are earnestly requested to co- operate with the school authorities and see that their children or wards are on the Assembly grounds, five minutes before the first bell.
4. Parents and Guardians are not allowed to see their children or meet the Teachers during School hours without prior permission.
5. Latecomers will not be sent to class. The school gates will be closed at 7.30 am after the bell. After which no student will be allowed in. If the student is found to be continuously coming late to School inspite of repeated warnings, she will be taken to task.
6. The Calendar must be brought daily to School.
7. Parents should regularly check their child's calendar and sign the notices and remarks found therein.
8. The Calendar should be used to write down the daily lessons and assignments given by the teacher.

9. The Parents and Guardians must see that their children do their homework and prepare their lessons daily . They should insist on punctuality and regularity in attending the class.
10. The School does not guarantee the success of a student. It is the duty of the Parents and Guardians to co-operate with the School authority and do their part by enforcing regularity and discipline.
11. Students will not be allowed to go home during school hours unless a parent or a responsible person comes to take them, for a valid reason.
12. Student suffering from any contagious or infectious disease will not be permitted to attend regular school or write exams. In which case, the parent is expected to report to the school along with a medical certificate immediately.
13. Students should realize that they are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also their general behaviour outside.
14. Leave of absence may be granted for a sufficient cause but only by a written application from the parent or guardian. This request must be made in advance or whenever possible.
15. On Open days, only the parents are permitted to see the Answer sheets.
16. Students should begin and close each period by devoutly reciting the Prayer before and after class.
17. At the end of each period, the students should silently wait for the next teacher.
18. The students will not be allowed to enter or leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher.

19. The students are expected to move in silence when changing classes and walk in a single file
20. At the end of the day, all the students should leave the class in silence and the teacher should be the last to leave.
21. When the attendance roll is called out, each student must rise and respectfully answer the roll call.
22. When a person in Authority enters the class, the students should stand respectfully.
23. In the absence of the teacher, the Class Leader will be responsible for the order and discipline of the class.
24. Strict regularity and implicit obedience is demanded from the students.
25. During the Recess, no student should remain in the classroom without the permission from the Authority.
26. Students are encouraged to attend School daily especially on the days of Evaluation unless they have a reason for their absenteeism.
27. The Report Cards should be duly signed only by the parents.
28. Books, magazines, DVDs, obscene books, newspapers, pictures, postcards, cell phones, electronic gadgets and playthings etc. not pertaining to the syllabus and not approved of by the Headmistress must not be brought to School.
29. Library books issued by the School should be returned by the students on time. If the book is damaged or lost, then the student will be charged for the same.
30. Catholic students are advised to go for Confession often and if possible, for Holy Mass and Communion daily. They

should say morning prayers and evening prayers, the Rosary and make an examination of their conscience every evening.

31. Irregular attendance, habitual inattention, misbehaviour, insubordination to teachers, serious misconduct, any kind of cheating, dishonesty in the School and even outside the School premises are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.
32. Students should not have any money or other valuable articles (expensive pens, compass boxes etc.) with them. Each student is responsible for her own belongings. The School is not responsible for the loss of any such articles.
33. All the students must be neat and tidy in person, dress and manners. Parents are requested to see that their children are neatly dressed to School wearing the School uniform, white canvas shoes and the socks recommended by the School.
34. The Squad badge should be worn daily.
35. The School Uniform should be knee length. Blue tights recommended by the school must be worn to School as a part of the school uniform.
36. During the Rainy season the students should wear black floaters without heels.
37. Hair should be neatly combed, and no colouring or mehndi is allowed.
38. Long hair should be neatly plaited into two and folded upwards with white ribbons. White hair bands should be used for short hair. No fancy clips, fancy haircuts or fancy hair bands are permitted.
39. Application of mehndi on the hands and wearing of gold ornaments or any other valuables is strictly forbidden.

40. Fingernails must be cut short and kept clean. No nail polish is permitted under any condition.
41. Students are not permitted to wear a wrist watch. Except during examination, a simple (thin black strap with a small dial) wrist watch may be allowed.
42. During the winter season, students are permitted to wear a blue sweater recommended by the School.
43. Students will have to bear the cost for any damages done to the School premises by them.
44. The students should always keep their books clean, and neatly covered with their names written on them.
45. Scribbling on book, desks, walls, etc. is absolutely forbidden.
46. Personal hygiene and cleanliness is expected from all.
47. Politeness, courtesy in speech and conduct, as well as cleanliness in dress and person is expected from every student.
48. During the Unit Tests and Examinations students are strictly warned not to carry any books. They must carry only their compass boxes with the required stationery within. Writing pads should be transparent.
49. Students are forbidden to give their teachers individual or collective gifts.
50. Students are liable to suspension from school on account of misbehavior.

Maria Teresa Goretti was born on October 16th, 1890 in Corinaldo, in the province of Ancona. She was the third out of six children. At the age of six her family had become so poor that they were forced to give up their farm, move and work for other farmers. Her father Luigi died when Maria was just nine. While her brother, mother and sisters worked in the fields, Maria would cook, sew and keep the house clean. She and her family moved to Le Ferriere in Lazio, where they lived in a building they shared with another family, the Serenellis.

On July 5th, 1902, finding eleven year old Maria alone sewing, Alessandro Serenelli came in and threatened her with death if she did not do as he said; he was intending to rape her. She would not submit, however, protesting that what he wanted to do was a moral sin. She desperately fought to stop Alessandro, a 20 year old farmhand from abusing her.

Alessandro at first choked Maria, but when she insisted that she'd rather die than submit to him, he stabbed her

11 times. The injured Maria tried to reach for the door, but Alessandro stopped her by stabbing her three more times before running away.

The following day, twenty hours after the attack, having expressed forgiveness for her murderer and stating that she wanted to have Alessandro in heaven with her, Maria died of her injuries, while looking at a very beautiful picture of the blessed mother.

Maria Goretti's feast day is celebrated on July 6th. Maria is the patron saint of chastity, rape victims, youth, teenage girls, poverty, purity and forgiveness.

She lingered on for three

days, during which the Christians who remained in Rome flocked to her house.
